## **CANZ – Professional Supervisors listing** *Requirements for applicants*

### **Aim:**

To provide appropriately qualified professional supervisors listed on the CANZ website; offering celebrants access to professional supervisors who understand their needs. CANZ acknowledges that celebrants deal with people from all 'walks' of life and at times may require the services of a supervisor to support wellbeing and professional growth and learning.

### **Requirements:**

- For applicants to hold an appropriate qualification that demonstrates their relevant clinical and work experience.
  - Certificates are accepted from NZAC (Counselling), ANZASW (Social Workers), NZAP (Psychologists), and NZ Psychologists Society (Psychologists). Other relevant certificates for clinical disciplines are accepted on a case-by-case basis for professionals who work with people.
  - APC (Annual practising certificate – clinical)
  - And/or a post-graduate "Certificate in Supervision"
- An understanding of the needs and requirements of a celebrant.

### **You will need to provide:**

- Your current CV
- Your annual practising certificate (APC) or a certified copy of your post-graduate qualification in Supervision
- A short bio to accompany your listing (no more than 250 words)
- One testimonial (from a supervisee) and two professional referees.
- An inclusion in your application of what professional bodies you are currently a member of.

### **Application to the CANZ 'supervision' working group:**

Applications will be forwarded to the lead of this group
- Applicants will be notified in writing of:
  - (a) their acceptance
  - (b) their decline
  - (c) or a request to provide further evidence

### **Annual update of your listing:**

If you hold a 'Certificate in Supervision' (which we have accepted and have on file), but no longer hold a clinical APC, it will be necessary to provide an annual summary of your work with clients. Include a precis of your ongoing professional development over the previous year.
